Discover three films from the video series below.


Hiyab – Los Angeles

Aryan – Afghanistan

Aryan, a 15-year-old refugee from Afghanistan, tries to shoot her living center in Berlin but is not allowed to show the crowded conditions, with many refugees coming and going, how hard it is to maintain social distance. When her family is moved to a remote location in the midst of the COVID-19 lockdown, she wonders what her future holds.
